

Assignment B4: lodine investigation: exploring local food sources

Explore local stores and markets to uncover iodine-rich foods. Collaborate with your group to select stores, examine products, and document findings. Prepare a presentation for the class.

Work with your assigned group to check if there are foods with iodine and iodised salt in local stores and markets.

Steps:

- 1. Choose stores: decide with your group which places to visit, like grocery stores and markets.
- 2. Explore: go to these places together and see if they have foods with iodine and iodised salt.
- 3. Collect information: write down what you find and take pictures, if needed.
- 4. Summarize: make a summary of what you have found providing an overview of good iodine sources.
- 5. Presentation: prepare a short presentation about what you have discovered.
- 6. Show it to your classmates: share your work with the class and highlight the take-home message that they can use, for example when they go shopping.
